## 1: What's in the box?

- 1 x Bottom Panel 1 x Top Panel 1 x Side Walls
- 1 x Centre Divider Panel
- 7 x Tie Down Straps
- 2 x Board Straps
- 1 x Set of Wheels



**2:** To build the board bag, start by locating the bottom panel (all silver panel) and lie this down on the floor, with the zipper at the top, and the straps and Velcro fold over at the bottom.



**3**: Locate the side walls and open up this section so that the zip connection aligns. Then zip these two pieces together. Please note the side wall is stiffer than conventional foam, you will need to gently push the side wall so that the zip can travel smoothly around the bag.



**4:** Locate the 2 x Board Straps. For each strap, there are two anchor points on the bottom panel, one set at the front and one at the back. Thread each strap through the two anchor loops on the bottom panel. Thread the loose end through the end loop on the board strap and secure it by using the Velcro.

**5**: Once your board is secured using the board straps, locate the center dividing panel. Lay the panel on top of the board and tuck the end around the tail of the board. Then secure the center panel to the side walls using the clips attached on both sides at the front and back – you can choose from multiple attachment heights on the side walls.



**6:** Locate the tie down straps. The center dividing panel has multiple options to add strapping to secure your foil mast, front and rear wings, and wing accessories. This is fully customisable. Simply loop the straps into your chosen formation and secure by fastening and tightening around the wing item. Once you have secured your kit to the center panel you can pack your wings, neoprene accessories and any further items on the top.



**7:** Locate the top panel, which is black with the 2XS logo, and align it with the side wall zips and zip together.



8: Turn the bag over and locate the wheels, these attach using Velcro and then secure onto the bag with two overlapping Velcro flaps which should be secured down. <u>Please note that</u> <u>the wheels must be removed and stowed inside the bag when you check the bag in - as these</u> <u>may come loose in transit and potentially lost. You can then unpack and reattach the wheels</u> <u>upon arrival at your destination.</u>



**9:** You're ready to go. Enjoy your trip!
